

2024 – UIM Anti-Doping Report

Education

The Union Internationale Motonautique (UIM) ensures that all its athletes and affiliated individuals are comprehensively educated on matters pertaining to anti-doping. At the outset of each season, the UIM disseminates crucial information and updates on anti- doping protocols through its Member Federations. Subsequently, these federations distribute the aforementioned materials to their respective international athletes and affiliated individuals. This educational initiative is primarily facilitated through the utilization of the ADEL platform, which encourages all athletes and riders to enroll and augment their understanding of anti-doping measures.

Furthermore, in the year 2024, the UIM organized two on-site event-based workshops in collaboration with the International Testing Agency (ITA), a partner of the UIM in anti- doping endeavors. The first workshop took place in Palermo, Italy. Attendance at this event was approximately 40 attendees, including athletes, support personnel for athletes, managers, and entourage members. Similarly, the second anti-doping workshop was held in Klaipeda, Lithuania, coinciding with the UIM Formula 2 World Championship. The participation was approximatively of 50 individuals, encompassing athletes, athlete support personnel, and entourage members.

Whereabouts Pools

In 2024, the Union Internationale Motonautique (UIM) had six athletes from four different nationalities in its UIM Testing pool. Athletes included in the UIM Whereabouts Pools are mandated to submit their Athlete Whereabouts on a quarterly basis through ADAMS, ensuring that their whereabouts are accurately maintained and updated in case of any changes. In adherence to these stipulations, during the course of 2024, the UIM recorded two Whereabouts Failures among its Testing Pool athletes, attributable to non-compliance with their Whereabouts requirements.
